Eligibility Requirements:

Students, who will be in 7th or 8th grade in the 2019-2020 school year, will have the opportunity to be considered for membership into the NJHS after the conclusion of the second marking period of 2019-2020 school year. Students considered for membership must have a cumulative grade average of 92 or above in their Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies classes for Semester 1 (both the first and second marking periods). Students who met the cumulative grade average at the conclusion of Semester 1 will be able to apply to the Honor Society in the winter of 2020.

Student Application Form:

In addition to a student's grades, acceptance to the NJHS also includes demonstrating service and leadership. Please use the application form prepared by the NJHS Faculty Council. The forms provide detailed information for service and leadership requirements. The application can be found on the Sayreville Middle School website or at the guidance office.

A Sayreville Middle School NJHS application form can serve as documentation for service and leadership activities. It is highly suggested that if the student is not currently involved with a volunteer or service program that they seek out opportunities throughout the school year.
